Additional Information

The Scoutland gate will be closed from 9 am until 12 pm and 1 pm to 5 pm during Saturday's activities. For the Safety of our scouts, No vehicles will be allowed in the campsite area during this time.

Camping and Parking

All cars will be parked in the main parking lot. **NO RIDERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BED OF TRUCKS OR TRAILERS. NO BICYCLES.** Camping will be by Pack and in an assigned campsite. However, due to the size and participation of this event, it may be necessary to combine packs within a campsite area. Please refrain from roping off your campsite area. Please DO NOT bring an axe, hatchet or chain saw to this event. Tent camping only (bring your own tent), no campers will be allowed in the campsites. Each unit is responsible for their own meals and equipment. Use of stoves and charcoal should follow BSA policies and guidelines. **Bring your own TOILET PAPER AND TRASH BAGS.** Latrines, restrooms, and shower facilities will be available. Radios, boom boxes, two-way radios, guns, fireworks, sheath knives, PETS, and alcoholic beverages are not allowed. All BSA and Northeast Georgia Council campground policies must be followed. Make sure all campfires are out and cold to the touch before retiring for the night and before you check out on Sunday.
