The **BALOO training** will give Cub Scout Leaders the tools they will need to successfully lead a pack camping program in their units. BALOO training will provide a new leader, with minimal camping experience, the basic skills needed for great pack camping outings.

Who should attend? All leaders eager to have a great pack outdoors program.

Is BALOO a required training? At least one adult on a pack overnigher **MUST** have completed Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO).

Items to bring with you:

Note: There will be no provisions for children.

BALOO is specifically designed for a Cub Scout leader who has minimal camping experience but wants to plan and carry out an entry-level outdoor experience for the pack.
