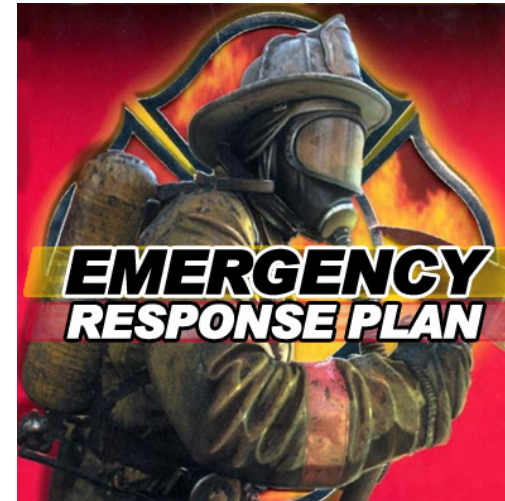

- Registration / Check In Guidelines**
1. Arrive at Scoutland Parking Lot.
  2. Send one adult leader to the registration / check in area.
  3. Combine all Pack equipment & Personal Gear into one or two vehicles (All vehicles must be parked in the main Parking lot)
  4. Move one vehicle into your campsite area and unload it, immediately return it to the main parking area. A second load may be taken at this time. (Note: In accordance with BSA policy, no one will be allowed to ride in the back of an open vehicle, i.e. pickup trucks or trailers.)
  5. Setup campsite (Note: Due to an expected large turnout, more than one Pack may be assigned to a campsite. Please be courteous to your neighbors.)
  6. Please follow the direction of all Staff & Traffic Coordinators. This will facilitate your getting checked in and to your campsite.
  7. Information packets will be given out Saturday at the Leaders Meeting.

General Information Registration

To register for Spring Fling, complete the attached application and return it to a Service Center of the Northeast Georgia Council, mail to the Lawrenceville Service Center, or fax to 770-962-8004.

Registration is \$10 per team (a team is a Scout and his adult partner) on or before March 9, 2010, \$15 from March 10th—March 18th, \$20 on the day of the event. Registration for Spring Fling is by Pack and not by individual.

Late registration is accepted on-site at Scoutland at the event. However, early registration allows the volunteers to appropriately plan for your Cub Scouts.

All Packs, whether they are pre-registered or not, must check in by Saturday, March 20th no later than 7:30 A.M. All Scouts must be on the parade field by 7:45 A.M.

The leaders should have medical form for each Scout and parent. (The BSA medical form #34605— new form can be found at :

<http://www.nega-bsa.org/pdf/MedicalForm34605.pdf>). You will be asked to present them at registration. Your pack will retain all medical forms and keep available at your campsite in the event of an emergency.



Spring Fling is an exciting overnight camping experience for a **BEAR** or **WEBELOS** Scout and his adult partner. Scouts will be working on the Emergency Preparedness award, **A Year of Celebration** ribbons, viewing group demonstrations, along with fun times for games, and campfire at the council's scout camp on beautiful Lake Lanier.

Camping and Parking

All cars will be parking in the main parking lot. Due to limited parking space carpooling is encouraged. Please see the check-in and registration guidelines pages. **NO RIDERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BED OF TRUCKS OR TRAILERS.**

Camping will be by Pack and in an assigned campsite. However due to the size and participation of this event, it may be necessary to combine packs within a campsite area. Please refrain from roping off your campsite area. Please **DO NOT** bring an axe, hatchet or chain saw to this event.

Tent camping only, no campers or R.V.'s will be allowed in the campsites. Each unit is responsible for their own meals and equipment. Please be sure to bring containers for water.

Use of gas stoves and charcoal should follow BSA policies and guidelines. Bring your own **TOILET PAPER** and **TRASH BAGS**. Latrines, restrooms, and shower facilities will be available.

Radios, boom boxes, two-way radios, guns, fireworks, sheath knives, PETS, and alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed. All BSA and Northeast Georgia Council campground policies must be followed.

Make sure all campfires are out before retiring for the night and before you check out on Sunday. A fire check will be made and you will be awakened to extinguish the fire if no one is tending it.

Be prepared for the weather. Because of cold nights, everyone should have a ski cap to sleep in.

Each BEAR/WEBELOS must have a responsible adult family member or guardian accompany them to Spring Fling according to BSA guidelines.

**BE SURE TO CARRY OUT YOUR OWN TRASH.** (It must leave Scoutland with you. We have a limited on-site disposal.)

Program Information

Any advancement that is completed during the event, is the responsibility of each Leader.

Dens/Patrols are encouraged to bring their patrol flags to Spring Fling for the "Best Patrol Flag" competition. Flags will be judged on creativity, use of natural materials and identification of the pack, den/patrol and all members of the den/patrol. Packs should carry their flags to all events on Saturday to show scout spirit.

Additional Information

Packs will not be allowed to check out until their campsite has been inspected. **Patches will be issued only after the campsite inspection.**

One patch per team will be provided with registration. Extra patches can be purchased for \$3 each while the supply lasts.

**THE LAKE WILL BE OFF LIMITS TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND STAFF.**

**Scoutland gate will be closed during events. No vehicles will be allowed in the camp during this time.**
