



Registration is open for the 2019 World Scout Jamboree and the council's International Committee is now accepting applications for fully-paid camperships.

To be considered for the campership, interested youth must complete the campership application AND apply to attend the Jamboree (<https://wsj2019.us/apply>), put down the \$250 deposit by the January 31, 2018 deadline and continue to pay according to the payment schedule. The Scout chosen for the campership will be reimbursed for any payments made. Demand for acceptance in the contingent is expected to be great. Prompt registration is highly recommended.

You must apply as a contingent participant and begin the payment process as scheduled.
