A good introduction to how Cub Scout dens and packs work and what a new leaders needs to know to kick off a great year for everyone. This is now available on the BSA On-line Learning Center at www.olc.scouting.org . A video is also available (a first come basis) at both the Lawrenceville and Jefferson Service Centers and may be checked out for five business days with a deposit of \$10.

Cub Scout Leader Position Specific Training (Available Leader Lead):

Designed to train a new leader in the specific responsibilities of his or her position. Specific training is available for Cubmasters, Tiger Cub Den Leaders, Cub Scout Den Leaders, Webelos Scout Leaders, and Pack Committee members.

Supplemental Training:

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO): Hands-on experience designed to give leaders the techniques they need to conduct a Pack Overnight Camping Trip. This is required for pack sponsored overnight trip. Pre-Requisites include Cub Leader Basic Training.

Outdoor skills training for Webelos Leaders: Provide essential outdoor skills for Webelos Leaders planning, conducting, and leading Webelos den camping.

University of Scouting: An exciting carnival of action, activities and program ideas. Held in the fall each year.

Unit Leadership Enhancements: On going training that is available at monthly pack leaders' meetings, selected from the 15 topics included in the Cub Scout Leader Book (33221).

Scouting Safety . . . Begins with Leadership: Video available at our two council service centers. Also check out Safety Afloat, Safe Swim Defense, and Hazardous Weather on-line training at www.olc.scouting.org.

Adult Leader Roundtables: Get the latest news and event flyers, in addition to meeting with experienced adult leaders to review ideas, crafts, and other useful program helps. Held monthly in each district.

Safe swim Defense: Required for all scout aquatics activities. See your Pack trainer or district calendar for dates and locations.

Woodbadge: Advanced training designed to provide leaders with leadership skills and a more dedicated involvement in Scouting. A limited number of courses are offered each year.

National Conferences: Offered at the Philmont Training Center in New Mexico and the Florida Sea Base in the Keys. See your District Executive for details.
