Class Information

Leatherworking/Basketry:

Have a fun day with crafts and earn 2 merit badges. There is a \$24 additional materials cost that provides for the 3 kits needed to complete the requirements of these badges.

First Aid:

First Aid will teach your Scout basic first aid skills, including how to provide emergency treatment for the most common injuries, from simple scrapes and cuts to broken bones. One of the Eagle required merit badges.

Archery:

Spend a day shooting archery. Sign up early, space is limited. There is an additional materials fee of \$17 that covers the cost of the arrow kit, string kit, and other items required for the badge.

Rifle Shooting:

This class will provide your Scout with basic shooting skills with a focus on safety principles. This is an extremely popular merit badge and space is limited. There is an additional \$5 fee to cover the cost of materials.

Woodcarving:

Learn a great skill and develop your artistic ability with this timeless merit badge. There is an additional materials cost of \$7 that provides for the cost of the kit needed to complete the requirements of this merit badge.

Communications:

Introduces your scout to basic communications skills, those used in both written and spoken communications. One of the Eagle required merit badges.

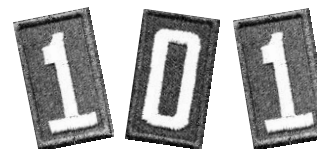
Swimming:
