Boy Scout Adult Leader Training

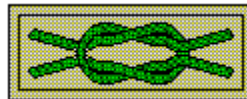

If you are registered as an Adult in a troop as: Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster, then this is the training for you. Committee Members and Chairmen are invited, but this is not required training for them (they should complete Troop Committee Challenge online).

Prerequisites for this course are Boy Scout Fast Start and “This is Scouting,” which are now offered by BSA on-line at <http://www.scouting.org/training>.

In addition to being able to wear the patch above, this course satisfies one requirement for the Adult Leader Knot. This class is also a prerequisite for Wood Badge.

More information on this will be provided during the classroom sessions.

Participants are encouraged to obtain and bring a copy of the current Scoutmaster Handbook and/or Troop Committee Guide to each session. These will be referenced in class. It also is recommended that you have your own copy of the Boy Scout Handbook.
