What You Need



These are the training classes you need to complete:

1. **Youth Protection** (on-line or in classroom)
2. **Cub Leader Position Specific** for your position (on-line or in classroom)

Your position is: Tiger Leader, Den Leader (Wolf or Bear), Webelos Leader, Committee Member, Committee Chair, Cubmaster, or Pack Trainer.

Assistant Leaders do exactly the same training as Leaders.

Keep copies of on-line completion certificates or trained cards.

These classes are recommended but not required:

BALOO- Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (classroom)

OWLS- Outdoor Webelos Leaders Skills (class- outdoors)

This is Scouting and **Fast Start** for your position (on-line)

Weather Hazards, Safe Swim, Safety Afloat, Climb Safely (all on-line)

Unless required for an activity, all other on-line classes are strictly optional.

For on-line training, go to www.myscouting.org → Create an account and log in → Click E-Learning at the left → Select Cub Scout → Choose.
