### New Boy Scout Troop Adult Leaders

## What You Need

### These are the training classes you need to complete:

- 1) **everyone:** Youth Protection, on-line or classroom
- 2) if you are a **Scoutmaster**, Assistant Scoutmaster, or Leader of 11 Year Old Scouts (LDS Units):  
Scoutmaster Specific, aka SALT, classroom only  
Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills, aka ITOLS, camping weekend only
- 3) if you are a **Troop Committee** Chair or Committee member:  
Troop Committee Challenge, aka TCC, on-line or in classroom  
Keep copies of on-line completion certificates or trained cards.

### These classes are recommended but not required for position:

This is Scouting and Boy Scout Fast Start (on-line)  
Weather Hazards, Safe Swim, Safety Afloat, Climb Safely, Trek Safely (all on-line)  
Unless required for an activity, all other on-line classes are optional.
