Rules and Regulations of the Boy Scouts of America

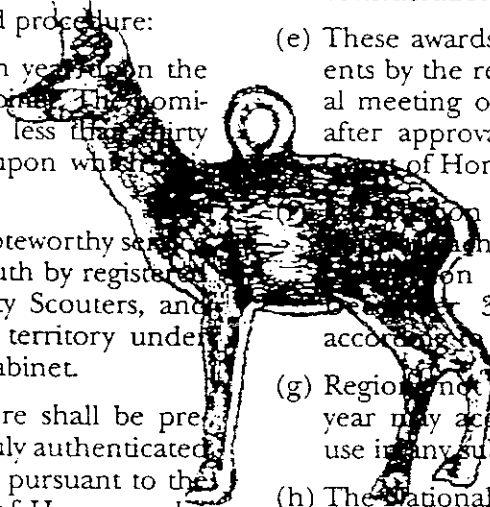
Article X, Section 6 — Silver Antelope Award

Clause 2. The Boy Scouts of America, acting through the National Court of Honor, may award the Silver Antelope for distinguished service to youth upon the following basis and procedure:

- (a) This award may be made each year upon the nomination of the regional cabinet. The nomination shall be submitted not less than thirty days in advance of the date upon which it is desired to present the award.
- (b) This award may be made for noteworthy service of exceptional character to youth by registered Scouters, Cub Scouters, Varsity Scouters, and Exploring leaders within the territory under the jurisdiction of a regional cabinet.
- (c) As evidence of the award there shall be presented: a suitable certificate, duly authenticated by the Boy Scouts of America, pursuant to the action of the National Court of Honor; and a miniature Silver Antelope suspended by an orange, white, and orange ribbon to be worn around the neck.
- (d) It shall be a general policy that no public announcements shall be made by the region in advance of

action of the National Court of Honor with reference to the names presented for consideration.

- (e) These awards shall be presented to the recipients by the region in connection with its annual meeting or other public function, but only after approval of the award by the National Court of Honor.
- (f) A region shall be entitled to one nomination for each thirty thousand registered adults on whom thereof in its territory, as of December 31 preceding the nominations, according to the records of the national office.
- (g) Regions not using their full allotment in any year may accumulate the unused portion for use in any subsequent year.
- (h) The National Court of Honor may, based upon initial recommendation of the Operations Group, award the Silver Antelope to persons in overseas areas.



Additional Information for the Region in the Final Process of This Nomination

1. The region may order Silver Antelope supplies directly from the National Distribution Center. A special order form for the Silver Antelope pendant, No. 92-106, is available from the National Court of Honor.
2. Policy limits the presentation of the Silver Antelope Award to *adults over 21 years of age who are registered as volunteer Scouters*. Nominations may not be made for posthumous awards.
3. Nominations will not be considered for former professional Scouters or council employees within five years of their leaving employment with the BSA (i.e., any form of employment such as secretary, ranger, camp staff member, or professional-technical position, or any form of temporary or full-time employment).
4. This nomination form must be sent to the National Court of Honor, S212 at the national office, at least thirty days before the award presentation. The nomination form will be processed and the certificate printed with appropriate signatures.
5. The region will be billed for printing and processing the Silver Antelope certificates.
